


## Gaining CPD with AMINZ A guide to Continuing Professional Development

Your CPD points can be gained across three categories. You will need to ensure you have gained points in at least two of the three categories each year. So, what constitutes a CPD point? Explore each category below and find out how many points you can gain based on the activities you participate in.



Category Gain CPD in this category Three: by participating in Attendance at Dispute Resolution **Events** 



AMINZ breakfast meeting 1 for participation, 2 for presentation

AMINZ Annual Conference 2 per half day of formal sessions

Informal mentoring or debriefing with a colleague (give or receive) 1 per time

AMINZ seminar 2 per half day

Other relevant seminar 1 per half day

Any other item Dependant

Joe Bloggs gained his required 30 points by:

Providing informal support to a colleague	10x = 10 points
Attending AMINZ Breakfast meeting	4x = 4 points
Acted in the capacity as a mediator	1x = 10 points
Attending AMINZ seminar	3x = 6 points
TOTAL	30 points
